General Guidelines

Prior registration to the conference is mandatory for any submission.

Abstracts can be submitted for 3 categories - Award Paper, Free Paper & E-Poster.

Award papers are open only for PLMs of IADVL. The presenters should be PLMs/LMs of IADVL.

Only original research studies and case series shall be considered for Award Paper Presentations.

Free Paper & E-Poster will have research studies, case series & case reports.

Presenting author can submit a maximum of 2 abstracts for consideration for DERMAZONE EAST & CUTICON NE STATES 2025 (maximum one for award paper).

Last date for submission of abstract is 20th October 2025.

All PG residents should submit a letter from the Head of Department certifying the authenticity of the paper and the category of paper submission.

Abstract Submission

Opens on: 1st July 2025 Closes on: 20th October 2025

Intimation: Regarding accepted abstract or paper or E-poster will be given on or before 30th October 2025.

Abstract Guidelines

All abstracts must be submitted in English, Font style of "Times New Roman", Font size of 12 and double spacing.

To ensure blinded review, no identifying features such as names of authors, collaborators, hospitals, medical colleges, clinics or places should be listed in the title or text page of the abstract. Author details and affiliation(s) to be mentioned in the email only, and not in abstract file.

Title should be written using "Sentence case" and should be brief and self-explanatory. Avoid abbreviations in the title. Word limit of the abstract is 250 words. (Excluding title, authors, their affiliations etc.)

Structure of the abstract for original study should include: Background, Aims and Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, limitations and conclusions.

Structure of the abstract for case report/series: Introduction, Case report/series, Discussion and Summary.

Abstracts must be original and must not have been published or presented at any other meeting.

Abstracts should report on results of truly original research. The proposal will be reviewed according to the scientific content and ethical considerations. Please ensure that the abstract contains original matter neither published prior in print or electronic media or presented in previous CUTICONS/DERMAZONES/DERMACONS.

FOR AWARD PAPER

- 1) The number of slides should not exceed 14, and will be allotted 7 minutes for presentation.
- 2) Do not mention identity of institute or any of the authors in the body of the abstracts.

FOR E-POSTER

- 1) The number of the slides should not exceed 5 slides, one each for introduction, material and methods, result, discussion and conclusion respectively.
- 2) The PPT size should not exceed 50 MB.

Refrain from using keywords, graphs, figures, tables or references in the abstract. Conflict of interest statement and declaration of conflict is mandatory.

Use generic names of drugs or its active pharmacological content, avoiding commercial names of drugs/companies.

Limit the use of abbreviations and acronyms in the abstract.

Abstracts may be reproduced as such, therefore onus of ensuring proper language, factual accuracy & responsibility of avoiding plagiarism lies with the authors.

Non-adherence to any guideline may result in an automatic rejection of the abstract. Once submitted by email you will receive acknowledgement of receipt.

NOTE: The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject any abstract, if the abstract is not submitted as per the guidelines.

TOURIST DESTINATIONS AT A GLANCE



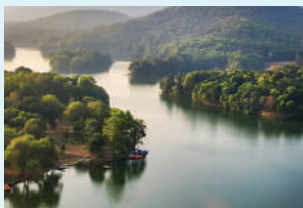
TRIPURA SUNDARI TEMPLE: Tripura Sundari temple occupies a place of distinction among all the Hindu religious shrines as it earns special veneration on account of being one of 51 Peethas of Hindu Centre of worship and submission. Located about 55 kms from Agartala City Centre.

UJJAYANTA PALACE: This Palace was built by Maharaja Radha Kishore Manikya in 1901 A.D; this Indo-Saracenic building is set in large Mughal-style gardens on a lake front. The palace has three domes each 86 feet high stunning tiles floor curved wooden ceiling and wonderful crafted door decor. Located at 01 km from Agartala city centre.



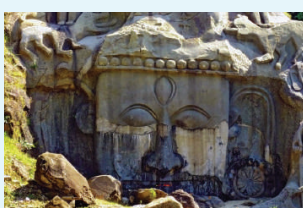
NEER MAHAL WATER PALACE: The place is a picturesque fairytale Royal mansion located in the middle of the Rudrasagar Lake which is 53 km South of Agartala. Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya built the palace in 1930 A.D as his summer residence being inspired by Mughal Style of Architecture.

CHABIMURA: Chabimura is famous for its panels of rock carvings on the steep mountain wall on the bank of Gomati. There are huge images carved of Shiva, Vishnu, Kartika, Mahisasurmardini Durga and other Gods and goddesses. Located about 78 kms from Agartala city centre.



DUMBOOR LAKE & NARKELKUNJA: Dumboor Lake is a charming water body located in Amarpur Sub Division and 115 km away from Agartala. The look of the lake is like tabor shaped small drum, 'Dumboor' of Lord Shiva from which the name 'Dumboor' originates.

SEPAHIJALA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY & CLOUDED LEOPARD NATIONAL PARK: The moist, picturesque biodiverse deciduous forest is the habitat of different species of primates like Rhesus macaque, Pigtailed macaque, Capped langur, Spectacled monkey and several other wild animals like Leopard, Clouded leopard, Jungle fowl, Deer, Wild pig, etc. Locate nearly 30 kms from Agartala city centre.



UNOKOTI: 'Shaiba' (Saivite) pilgrimage and dates back to 7th – 9th centuries if not earlier. The marvellous rock carvings, murals with their primitive beauty, waterfalls are not to be missed. Located about 178 kms from Agartala city centre.
